
If you qualify for VA health care, you can receive coverage for the services you need to help you get—and stay—healthy.

The AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) helps ensure that individuals who are living with HIV and AIDS and are uninsured and underinsured have access to medication.

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for ADAP enrollment in Maryland, an individual must meet all of the following criteria:

- Have a positive HIV/AIDS diagnosis
- Be a Maryland resident
- Qualify financially (anticipated gross annual household income must be at or below 500% of the current federal poverty level for the size of the legal household)
- Not be eligible for Maryland Medical Assistance (Medicaid)
- Have submitted a complete Maryland ADAP application with required documentation

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for ADAP enrollment in Washington, DC, you must:

- Have a positive HIV/AIDS diagnosis
- Provide proof of District of Columbia residency
- Provide medical verification: Your physician must complete and sign DC ADAP's medical eligibility form verifying your HIV/AIDS status. ALL INFORMATION IS CONFIDENTIAL.
- Provide proof of income: Financial eligibility is based on 500% of the federal poverty level (FPL). FPL varies based on household size and is updated annually. Financial eligibility is calculated on the gross income available to the household.

If you wish to apply on paper, please note: Along with a complete application, documentation of residency, income and HIV status is required. The last page of the application must be submitted by a doctor.
